Tuesday July 5, with Shulie Mishkin:

Who by Memory- How Does Israel Remember (and sometimes forget).

A tour of the Mount Herzl cemetery and the new Hall of Remembrance.

Meet at Mount Herzl, from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm

We will visit the incredible new Hall of Remembrance and take part in the daily memorial cemetery as well as having a tour. We will continue with visiting some of the powerful graves and memorials of this iconic cemetery, including the Ethiopian memorial, the fighters of 1948, and the Dakar submarine memorial. As Rabbi Shlomo Zalman Auerbach said - you do not need to go north to visit graves of the righteous, the cemetery on Mount Herzl is full of them.

Tuesday July 12, with Miriam Tekuzener:

Motivated to Act- Emotions Behind the Founding of the State.

A Jerusalem tour of King George Street and Rechavia.

Meet at 9:00 am from Gan Ha'Sus (King George Street 18), finish at approximately 1:00 pm at Heichal Shlomo

Hear the stories behind the scenes of the first Knesset, the Jewish Agency, the Great Synagogue and the Gymnasia.

We will follow in the footsteps of those who dreamt, hoped and acted to make the State of Israel a reality. You will learn the inside scoop of the coffee breaks, the drama, and the everyday life of Rabbi Herzog, Ben Gurion, the characters from "The Beauty Queen of Jerusalem," and many more.

Our tour will end with a visit of the newly renovated museum in Heichal Shlomo, where we will see the chambers of Rabbi Herzog, the first hand written draft of the prayer for the State of Israel, and many other artifacts that tell the stories of a nation waiting to come home.
